CATCH & RELEASE

All fishing is catch and release only; all fish are required to be returned to the water (with the exception of invasive Asian Carp).

EQUIPMENT

The York Center Park District loans out free fishing poles during regular office hours, sponsored by the Illinois Department of Natural Resources. Leave a valid I.D. at the front desk and please return the pole in its original condition.

OFFICE HOURS

Mon-Fri 9:00am-4:00pm

Administrative offices are located at 1609 S. Luther Ave. Lombard. It is four blocks east of Roosevelt Road and two blocks east of Meyers Road.

RULES

- ◆ Park and fishing hours are from dawn to dusk
- ◆ Illinois State Fishing License is required to fish at both parks
- ◆ Fish from shore only
- ◆ Only two poles per fisherman
- ◆ NO Minnows, Corn, or live bait will be allowed (Worms are permitted)
- ◆ No Swimming
- ◆ Boats, canoes, rafts, and other flotation devices are not allowed.
- ◆ No alcoholic beverages
- ◆ Removal of plants and animals is prohibited.
- ◆ Hunting and trapping is prohibited.
- ◆ **DO NOT FEED THE WILDLIFE.**
