All participants must sign the multiple waiver and release form which is located on the reverse side of the registration form.

INSURANCE: The York Center Park District does not provide medical insurance coverage for those participating in recreation programs or while using park facilities. Such insurance would make programs and user fees prohibitive.

CODE OF CONDUCT/BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS:

YCPD participants are expected to demonstrate appropriate behavior at all times. The following is a list of the Park District's behavior codes, which have been developed to help make the programs safe and enjoyable for all participants. Additional rules or guidelines may be developed for specific programs if deemed necessary by YCPD staff.

1. Show respect to fellow participants and staff.
2. Abstain from using abusive or foul language.
3. Abstain from causing or threatening bodily harm to self, fellow participants or staff.
4. Show respect to equipment and facilities.

Additional or individual behavior management plans may be developed based on the advice of parents, guardians, YCPD staff, or other professionals. A caring, fair and positive approach will be utilized regarding the use of any disciplinary methods. Each situation will be evaluated individually and on its own merit. YCPD reserves the right to dismiss a participant at any time.

AMERICAN DISABILITIES ACT (ADA): People with disabilities, please note: The York Center Park District will not discriminate against eligible residents for participation on the basis of a disabling condition. "We invite any participant with a special need to contact our staff upon registration so that a smooth inclusion may occur." These organizations pooled their resources to contract Ray Graham Association for People with Disabilities to provide programs and services to individuals with disabilities in their communities. Over 300 individuals are served annually through recreational activities, including music, drama, sports, arts and crafts, social activities, and special events.

Pet Owners: When visiting the parks with your pet, please remember that the district's ordinance requires dogs to be leashed at all times. The person in control of the pet is responsible for cleaning up waste.

Notice of Possible Changes in Brochure Listings: In order to provide the best services, programs and facilities to the public, the district reserves the right to add, change, modify or delete any program or policy after they have been published. The park district will attempt to make a reasonable effort to give prompt public notice of any material changes in the programs and policies.

Refunds: Some programs (like camps) may have specific refund policies and will be listed on the program's page on our website. Refund requests must be submitted at least one week prior to the start of a program or class. A \$5.00 service fee will be deducted from the amount paid and a check will be mailed to the recipients address. No cash refunds will be given. Refunds cannot be given for outings unless a substitute can be found beforehand or if the trip is canceled. Please note: Due to circumstances beyond York Center Park District's control, some trips or programs may be subject to change or cancellation. Please register early so we do not have to postpone or cancel programs.

Park Rentals

PARK RENTAL HOURS:
9:00am until dusk



The parks are available for your use & enjoyment. Any group of 20 or more people must submit a rental application.

Permission to use the parks & facilities will be granted only where the park system can reasonably accommodate such use & will not unduly interfere with the rights of the public, public health & safety of the community.

Groups of 100 or more people must receive YCPD Board approval. Application for groups of 100 or more must be turned in 45 days prior to desired rental date.

Permission to use the parks will be granted AFTER:

- 1) The YCPD receives the completed rental request application 2 weeks before desired rental date.
- 2) YCPD receives proof of residency &/or copy of valid state ID.
- 3) YCPD has received a Certificate of Insurance, when applicable.
- 4) Application has been processed & approved.
- 5) All fees have been paid 2 weeks prior to the first rental date.
- 6) A YCPD Park Rental Permit has been issued.

Facility Rentals



The York Center Park District rents the meeting rooms and gymnasium at the community center to groups and individuals. Note: The gym is over 3,300 square feet. Groups that are interested in renting the gym or meeting rooms may contact the park district for a rental application. Rental applications must be completed and turned into the York Center Park District office 2 weeks prior to the desired rental date. If the application is approved, then the Security Deposit, Certificate of Insurance (if applicable) and the full rental amount is to be turned into the York Center Park District front office 1 week prior to the rental date. Failure to comply can result in loss of your desired rental reservation. Cancellation of reservation must be made 48 hours prior to the rental time by notifying York Center Park District at (630) 629-0886. Failure to comply will result in loss of Security Deposit and the rental amount.


